This companion guide presents the complete recorded prayer together with Scripture passages that support each line or thought. Some lines closely echo the wording of Scripture; others are prayer language drawn from Scriptural principles and imagery. The references are provided to encourage further study in context, not as a claim that every prayer line is a direct quotation.

A NOTE ABOUT THE SCRIPTURE REFERENCES

Readers are encouraged to open each cited passage and read it in its surrounding context. Several declarations in this prayer are drawn almost directly from passages such as Tehillim (Psalm) 27, 35, 64, 91, 121, 138, 139, and 143. Other statements combine Scriptural themes - such as YAHUAH setting boundaries, exposing hidden counsel, restraining the adversary, guarding His servant, and bringing wicked schemes to nothing - into prayer language.

The purpose of the references is to keep the prayer anchored in Scripture while preserving the wording of the recorded prayer. Where a line is an application rather than a quotation, the citation points to the Scriptural principle underlying that prayer.

May we always allow YAHUAH to search our own hearts as we ask Him to judge rightly, defend His servants, expose wickedness, and establish His will.
